Hello April! This past weekend was very busy one for all of our volunteers. We spent most of Saturday inside training while it was beautiful outside. Then we spent three hours outside conducting emergency preparedness outreach on Sunday in the cold rain. Sounds terrible, but our volunteers are here to overcome great obstacles. And this is what you do everyday!!! 32 volunteers training on new Medical Countermeasures (MCM) screening and dispensing procedures, 3 volunteers improving the emergency preparedness of a community and recruiting at least one new volunteer. He will join seven others who completed their Citizen Corps of Delaware County (CCDC) orientation training last week. Many more have joined over the winter. New volunteers are the life blood of our Corps. They provide new energy and keep those who came before them on their toes. When new volunteers get a hat, a shirt, or their blue vest they are just starting to understand what the rest of us are talking about. THE BLUE ARMY! In a sense this is who we are. People working together with one concentrated purpose, to improve the preparedness of our communities.
