It is very important that we all work to inform the public to take appropriate actions when an advisory, watch or warning is issued. Some homes were destroyed and many others had major damage. Luckily no one was killed! We need to be prepared by having a kit, having a plan, and being informed. Take a few minute to insure that you are connected with Delco Alert, https://www.delcopa.gov/delcoalert/delcoalert.html and make sure our family, friends, coworkers and neighbors are also connected. Check your supplies kit, your go bag, and anything else you have stocked for emergencies. Remember, we are the example and it is up to us to show the entire county how to be prepared.

We will also check our preparedness at our annual logistics exercise on Saturday, July 27th. Registration is included in this bulletin. Please join us as we work together to reorganize and account for our mass care and public health equipment and exercise our volunteer reception center. Lunch will be provided. A great time to network with other volunteers!!! We also have the opportunity to exercise our MCM Strike Team on Saturday, November 2nd as part of a large multi-state MCM response. We plan to take 100 volunteers into another county and set up an entire POD. Please check the last page of this bulleting for details. The Salavation Army has successful conducted their Grand Opening in Rutledge last week. Now we need to recruit volunteers to affiliate with the Salvation Army to staff their canteen. November 2, 2019—7 am to 7 pm—Delco MRC Strike Team Deployment Exercise.

This is a huge event for the CCDC! We are planning on having 100 of our volunteers participate in this exercise. The goal is to set up an entire POD including all the line management, first aid, command and control, disability access, screening, dispensing, QA/QC, mass care for the volunteers, feeding of the volunteers, and transportation from our rally point to the POD location. It is all very exciting but will take a lot of work from our volunteers. Each section of the POD will be divided up and you will have an opportunity to join a section over the summer and start training together as a group. Each group will train through September, then we will conduct a full scale exercise in September and again in October before we complete the final exercise on November 2nd. Please consider joining a group for this exercise. More information and registration will be forthcoming in a special message.
