Last week we learned that our Medical Reserve Corps, the backbone of the Citizen Corps of Delaware County (CCDC) Program, has been nominated for the "Community Response Award" as part of the 2019 MRC Recognition Awards Program sponsored by the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR). Saturday, March 16 from 8 am to 4 pm—Psychological First Aid- an evidence-informed modular approach to help children, adolescents, adults, and families in the immediate aftermath of disaster, terrorism, and other crisis events. It is designed to reduce the initial distress caused by traumatic events and to foster short- and long-term adaptive functioning and coping. This 6 hour PFA course will offer an introduction to basic emergency behavioral health, information on normal reactions to disaster, and will teach the 8 Core Actions of PFA to assist responders in working with survivors of critical events in a compassionate and non-intrusive manner.
